Over the last 5 years, we have helped 17 students continue their education without financial hurdles. These children come from low-income families, where their parents struggle to make ends meet. We identified them through our friends and family, verified their background, spoke with their school management, and made direct partial fee payments to their school accounts. This ensures that we are supporting deserving students and that our funds are used appropriately.

11 th grade	Father works in a workshop; Mother does tailoring
4 th grade	Father passed away during covid; Mother works in a xerox shop
11 th grade	Father washes car at houses; Mother works in a garments shop
7 th grade	Father works in a juice shop; Mother is a flower vendor
4 th grade	Father is an auto driver; Mother is a housewife
1 st grade	Father is a tailor; Mother is a housewife
